ADDITIONAL RULES:

EASTERN NATIONAL 4-H HORSE ROUNDUP (2008)

Individuals may participate in only one contest per year.

An individual may not compete in the same specific contest again at Eastern or Western Nationals.

Certification of participation eligibility should consider the following:

“This contestants has not participated in post-secondary course work in the subject area of the national 4-H competition, nor has he or she participated in training for post-secondary competition in the subject area of the national 4-H competition.” See details below.

- A. Post-secondary undergraduate students may participate in and/or complete freshman and sophomore level equine management or communications courses. Students completing a junior, senior or graduate level equine and/or communications course are ineligible to participate in the National 4-H Horse Competition.
- B. Students are ineligible to participate in a National 4-H Horse Competition if they are currently enrolled in courses that provide specific training for the competitive event in which they are participating.

For example, student participation in collegiate horse judging events, on intercollegiate horse judging teams and in intercollegiate communication events would eliminate a 4-Her's eligibility to participate in the National 4-H Horse Competition.

ARABIAN HORSE JUDGING CONTEST, NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP SHOW:

**All past high overall individuals are ineligible to compete again.

Can not have competed on a college judging team

QUARTER HORSE CONGRESS:

Speaking/Demonstration Contests, there is no quota, we could send more than one.

Individuals may participate in more than one contest per year. Individuals are allowed to compete in both Hippology and either Speaking/Demo or Horse Bowl. Speaking/Demo and Horse Bowl individuals could also compete in Hippology or Judging. (Contestants must win a MN State trip in order to do this)

**An individual is ineligible if they were a high individual overall or on the high overall team.

Contestants may not have participated in an official, post secondary Hippology, Horse Bowl or Horse Judging contest, nor have been in training in preparation for one of these contests.
